

## Clay County Campgrounds

### General Rules and Regulations:

1. Pets must be kept on leash at all times. Campers are expected to pick up after their animals.
2. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on all public use areas.
3. Firearms, fireworks, or other potentially lethal devices are not permitted.
4. Children should be supervised by an adult at all times.
5. Dishwashing is prohibited at drinking faucets and comfort station facilities.
6. Garbage and trash should be placed in bags and placed in dumpsters.
7. Wildlife and plant life on the premises are for you to enjoy but should not be disturbed.
8. Motor vehicles should only be used when necessary. No driving on streets unless licensed driver, including motorcycles.
9. Do not place trash in fire rings.
10. One camping unit and one vehicle are allowed per campsite, unless additional vehicles are registered with the campground host. Additional vehicles should leave the grounds prior to 10:00 p.m. Visitor vehicles who stay overnight will be charged \$2.00/day.
11. Additional camping units sharing the same site will be charged the usual camping fee.
12. No camping other than in designated sites unless arranged by the campground personnel or host.
13. Quiet time is 10:00 PM - 7:00 AM. Disruptive noise or behavior is prohibited. Violators will be asked to comply or leave the campground.
14. Health Department regulations require that all wastewater be collected in suitable containers and disposed of at the dump stations.
15. Washing RV's and Vehicles is prohibited.
16. One tarp is permitted over the camper or picnic table.
17. All campsites must be neat. Boat trailers should be parked in designated parking zones.
18. No Unauthorized Porches, Decks, or Steps. **Absolutely no carpet allowed on the shoreline.**
19. Upon ending your stay remove all personal property and properly dispose of all litter by placing in dumpsters near dump station.
20. The Campground Host on duty is for the safety of you and other campers on the grounds. Campers must respect, obey and comply with all requests made by the Host.
21. Clay County reserves the right to change or add any rule without notice.
22. Reservations for 14-day camp sites can be made using Reserve America.
23. Pavilions may be reserved by calling (828) 557-6788.
24. Any camper left over 14 days will be towed at camper's expense.
25. Boats or other property that is abandoned will be removed from the property and or towed at owner's expense.
26. No lights are permitted on tarp or around camper
27. Check-in time for 14-day campers is 3:00 PM – 10:00 PM., and check out time is 1:00 PM
